### **Our New Pastor**

Fr. Marian Gil OMI was born on August 3, 1962 in Poland. In 1981 he entered the Novitiate of the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate. From 1982 - 1988 he studied philosophy and theology at Oblate seminary in Obra, Poland. In 1988 he was ordained to the ministerial priesthood and the same vear he arrived to Canada. Since his arrival he was involved in pastoral ministry. During this time, he also initiated the Festival of Religious Song which would in later years become known as the International Festival of Religious Song. In 1993, based on a request from the Provincial, he formed a pastoral ministry geared towards the youth for Assumption Province. In 1994, he began his radio ministry under the name of Catholic Youth Studio -KSM Inc., which later on became a non-profit media corporation for evangelization. From 2011-2017, he served two terms as Provincial of Assumption Province. As of September 1, 2018, Fr. Gil is the pastor of St. Teresa Parish in Kitchener, Ontario. He comes from a large family; he has one brother and five sisters. His hobbies include tennis, involvement in the media, reading books and an active interest in news services. (cont'd)

**Oblates of Mary Immaculate**, founded in France in 1816 by St. Eugene Demazenod. In 1841, at the invitation of Bishop Bourget, Canada became their first foreign mission. With steady reinforcement from France and Canadian recruits, they moved up the Ottawa Valley, and in 1845 into the North-West, where the establishment of the Catholic Church in western Canada was largely Oblate work. Presently there are about 4000 Oblates and they serve in 72 countries.
