Drought in the Horn of Africa puts 10 million at risk. The worse drought to impact the Horn of Africa in 60 years has put an estimated 10 million people at risk of severe food shortages and famine. Development and Peace is closely monitoring the situation and will support the people in the region as they face this rapidly escalating humanitarian crisis. The people of Somalia have been hardest hit by this drought, which is also affecting other countries in the region, including Ethiopia, Djibouti and Kenya. Thousands of Somalis are making an exhausting trek to Kenya in hope of reaching camps where they can receive humanitarian aid. However the long journey is worsening the health of many already weakened by malnutrition, particularly children, who often arrive with critical medical needs. The Caritas network is making preparations to support the most needed of these people and Development and Peace, as a member of the Caritas confederation of Catholic aid organizations worldwide, is accepting donations to go towards relief in the region. Development and Peace has been responding to humanitarian crises in the Horn of Africa for over 35 years. In the last ten years, it has contributed close to \$2 million to food security projects in the region.
