In today's Gospel Jesus speaks about prayer of petition, asking God for what we need (as opposed to just what we want or would like to have). The Gospel is a parable about a judge and a poor widow who is seeking justice. The point is that if even a totally corrupt person who cares neither for God nor man can be made to yield to the pestering of a totally defenseless and resource less widow, how much more will a loving and caring God take care of his children? The lesson then is to keep on asking.
