Here is the wonder of our King and what it means to be part of his Kingdom. It is beautifully described in the Preface to the Eucharistic Prayer in today's Mass:

"As King he claims dominion over all creation, that he may present to you, his almighty Father, an eternal and universal kingdom; a kingdom of truth and life, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace."

Our King has been chosen for us by God but it is for each one of us to profess our allegiance to him. Today we are called to work together to expand the reality of his Kingdom in our families, in our society and in the world generally.
